MONTPELLIER (SÈTE), FRANCE

Montpellier has been a center of learning for centuries. Its namesake university, founded in 1160, is one of the world's oldest, predating the Renaissance. Still, a student population breathes life into a vibrant culture. Built on two hills along the Lez River, the city grew as a spice-trading city and a center of medicine under the Kings of Aragon. The social and cultural center of Montpellier is the Place de la Comédie, anchored by the elegant Three Graces fountain and the stunning, neoclassical Opéra Comédie. Other sites pay tribute to a rich heritage, from the art-filled Musée Fabre and impressive St. Clement Aqueduct to the St. Pierre Cathedral with its "floating" porch supported by a pair of towers.

The local currency in Sète, France is the Euro (EUR). The approximate exchange rate is €0.91 EUR to \$1.00 USD. We regret that Euro cannot be purchased or exchanged on board.

Inter-Port Shuttle Bus

As per Sete Terminal Regulation walking inside the port is not allowed therefore the local authorities will be providing a complimentary shuttle bus from the vessel to the Port Entrance. The shuttle bus will be running every 15 minutes. This service will begin at 8:00 AM from the port. The last shuttle bus from the Port Entrance back to *Viking Mars* will be at 7:30 PM.

Value-Added Tax (VAT) Notice & Refunds

As this itinerary sails within Spain, members of the European Union (EU), products purchased in our onboard shops and spa will be subject to a VAT of 21% as per EU regulations.
