

Booking Shore Excursions

For your ease and comfort please find the below options for booking additional Shore Excursions.

iTV – Interactive Television in your stateroom allows you to book tours with your television remote. Select: Home Screen, Shore Excursions, Optional or Included, Date & Tour Name.

Viking Voyager App – This mobile application allows for you to book tours with your personal cell phone. In the application select: Shore Excursions, Select Date, Select Tour Name.

How to Connect to the Internet

The Viking wireless network requires authentication with a four-digit PIN. To get started, select "Viking Mars" on your device. When the log-in page opens, enter your stateroom number, your last name and your birth year, then press "Next". You will then be prompted to create your four-digit PIN before being connected to complimentary Wi-Fi service.

Internet Access

All our ships offer free Wi-Fi. You may use your personal device or one of the ship's computers in our Business Center on Deck 1. Our connection relies on a VSAT satellite terminal—the best possible solution for ocean cruising. Due to the nature of data bandwidth and latency, as well as potential interruptions in satellite signals based on terrain and weather, you may experience slower online connections than you are accustomed to at home. In order to ensure fair usage for all, we reserve the right to limit heavy-bandwidth applications, downloads or software upgrades so that all our guests have access to Wi-Fi. We suggest that you limit large uploads/downloads. We would be pleased to help you with your device settings; please visit Guest Services on Deck 1. We hope you will understand that we will do our very best to provide you with an enjoyable online experience, and remember, you will likely be able to access standard Wi-Fi and data roaming services on shore in most towns and cities you visit.


racing series. In business, Clive has led the introduction of innovative technologies into global markets and authored several books on risk and change.

Dress Codes Reminder
